

Win-Test V4 NAME or FRIEND Files Instructions

File name name.xdt


Make sure the file downloaded okay by viewing the file with Notepad.

The first few lines of the file with the club flag should look like this:

```
# TITLE Op Name - Section - State/Province 2022-03-20
AA0AC DAVE MN MN MWA
AA0AW DOUG MN MN MWA
```

Next follow these instructions:

1. Save file in C:\ProgramData\Win-Test\extras
2. On the Menu bar go to – **WINDOWS...** and click on Extra Information
3. Right click in the pop up window select **Extra Data Files**.
4. If the name.xdt is not listed, select ADD and add it to the list.
5. Click OK



To send hi to the person in CW or RTTY it will take a different name.xdt file. With this file you will not get the ARRL Section or the State. Edit the file with Notepad to appear as follows:

```
# TITLE Op Name
# VARIABLE $OPNAME
AA0AW HI Doug
AC0LL HI Bruce
AC0W HI Bill
AC0X HI Lou
AF9T HI John
```

Follow previous instruction to display the name on the screen.

In the message you wish to say HI NAME add into the message \$OPNAME.
