13th Annual MNQP

2011 was not to be the year like last, where many scoring records were set. However this year we achieved another very important record in that the total participation in the number of logs received was another all-time high. (249)

With this year's event we began equal point value for CW and SSB contacts and added the "Phone Only" category for the non-MN stations, so we certainly have a record setting winner in that category.

I must admit that this year for the first time my focus on MNQP was just not there. My mind was focused on a ham radio adventure that was to be about a month away. I usually take good notes on paper and in my mind about the weather conditions that the mobiles endured, how the propagation and band conditions treated the participants, and other misc. notes. Instead I found myself with barely a recollection of even participating. Based on the photos submitted, we must have had a "typical" Minnesota winter day, which makes many of you scratch your heads about why our mobiles go out and about. I hope you all created some good enjoyment by participating, and that we see you next year!

Also, a big thank you goes out to everyone who assisting in score tabulating, article writing, etc.

Minnesota (In-State) Results

Last year Pat – K0PC detailed some of the highlights, AND some of the pitfalls of what can occur to the mobile contester. Apparently Murphy stayed away just enough to enable Pat to take the top spot in the Mobile category this year. I did a quick check of the previous years results and see that Pat has been climbing the ranks, but I

believe this is the first time at the top of the list.

AI –K0AD & Dan -N0PI have a well tested setup for the Mobile Unlimited, and no surprise they're back again at the top in this category.

In the multi-op category, the crew at W0MR simply tripled their score from last year which catapulted them into to the top spot, just edging out the N0RPJ duo.

Jim-N0UR dominated the QRP category with a repeat win. His QRP and rover signal pulled in a boatload (or is that carload?) of multipliers.

Dan-K0TI repeats as the top score entrant in the SOLP category operating K0FVF.

Jack –N0XT returns to the top spot in the Phone Only category. A win in 2009, and a break in 2010, this

year Jack takes advantage of the two point QSO's and more then triples his 2009 score.

Non-Minnesota Results

Tom-N2CU is once again the top finisher in the SOLP category. Although the scores are down from last year in this category, it is still the most popular category. Tom topped the list last year, and before that in 2007 surprisingly without nabbing at least 80 counties. Only KB9S across the border managed that, just six shy of that sweep which hasn't been seen since 2009.

In the Single OP High Power category Jeff N8II from West Virginia tops the list with a score increase over last year's effort good enough to jump from a 2nd place finish to top spot edging out some top notch competition.

If you have ever operated a MNQP before, then you probably already know who is our QRP category winner for 2011. In 2010-yes the same. 2009, 2008, and 2007 – Yes, all the same.... Well that would be Jules N2WN for his fifth in a row.

In the newly formed Phone only category, Ron – W1KDA from Rhode Island takes top honors and now hold the current all time record for this category. Ron's comments were "Look forward to next year", and rightfully so; he will have a

title to defend.

Laci - OM2VL was trying to work in some MNQP contacts while trying for a RTTY contact with the VP8ORK DXpedition. Despite this distraction and band conditions, he tops the DX Unlimited spot this year.

The top non-MN club with as many entrants as any MN club goes to the Tennessee Contest Group.

Perspectives of a 1st time MNQP rover by Rich Westerberg – $N\emptyset HJZ/m$

Although I am a seasoned veteran of many VHF and UHF rover trips, I had never operated mobile on HF. With the help of Jon, W0ZQ, I decided to give mobile operation a try in the 2011 Minnesota QSO Party.

I ordered hamsticks for 20 and 40 meters and an MFJ magnetic mount for the roof of our van. Jon had offered his FT100 rig so I'd have 100 watts on all bands. Jon helped me get the wiring set and also helped re-engineer the MFJ base (it is really poorly constructed). Now I needed a plan. I would travel alone and this would be my first HF adventure. I wanted to stay on some main roads and stay near the Twin Cities, yet I wanted to hit many counties during the ten hours of the contest. I decided I would not operate while driving. The final plan would have me operate from seven counties and end near home. I figured my trip would result in seven hours of operating out of the ten-hour contest. Early Saturday I packed the van and drove west towards Meeker County. An early arrival gave me time for a pre-game snack and a chance to refill the gas tank. I found a nice open area with a quiet road in Meeker County, right near the Kandiyohi County border. I got all set up and ready. As the contest was about to start I

had my one (and only) visit by law enforcement. The Cop didn't understand what I was doing but he moved on.

I started the contest on 40M CW and stayed there for a half hour. I'm a much better Phone operator and the QRM on CW was tough. Moving to 20M Phone gave me a chance to find a clear frequency and I ran for a bit. It was time to move and I only had 49 QSO's in 64 minutes of operating. Not the rates I wanted. I made a quick move to Kandiyohi County and started on 20M. The QSO's flowed quicker as the band was open, coastto-coast. I made a quick stop on 40M CW but I

couldn't keep the rate going. I spent 64 minutes in Kandiyohi County (like Meeker) but made 87 QSO's.

The next few hours were a blur. I'd drive quickly to the next county, run on 20M and make a quick stop on 40M, then pack-up and do it again. For me, 20 meters was the best band and I got a good run from each stop. I finally made it into Hennepin County and spent a bit over 90 minutes operating. The contest ended and I was exhausted. I ended up right about at my goal. I operated 7 hours and 29 minutes out of the ten-hour contest.

It was a thrill to "be the

DX" during this short contest. Lots of people would listen for me from each stop and that made it lots of fun! Thanks to everyone who worked me. I'll be out again next year and hope to operate from a different route from some rarer counties. I'd recommend mobile operating to everyone. It's a blast!
